

Devon writer launches new thriller during National Crime Reading Month

Devon businessman turned writer Terry Green is holding a series of author events at Devon libraries this June to introduce his latest crime thriller and support the Crime Writers Association's (CWA) National Crime Reading Month (NCRM).

A new life of crime

Terry's tour includes two free talks at Plymouth Libraries – 13:30 on Saturday 30 May at Plymouth Central Library and 11:00 on Thursday 11 June at Plymstock Library. From the man who introduced the British habit of queueing to more than 40 countries as the voice of 'Cashier Number Three, Please', here's the chance to hear about the twists and turns of Terry's new 'life of crime'. Plus, find out more about 'Dangerous Art', published 21 May, which continues the nail-biting adventures of hero Jake Elderfield, a management accountant turned corporate fire-fighter.

Already a twice-published business author with a career spanning cars to customer service, Terry turned to crime writing in 2025. He quips: "One reader said my business book, 'You're Next', read like a thriller. So it got me thinking, why not?!"

Now, Terry has his foot to the floor as a crime thriller writer, author speaker and member of the CWA. His debut novel, 'Redline', the first in a series, is a fast and furious story set in the glamorous, high octane world of sports cars; with a host of 5* reviews, it has been dubbed 'a race from start to finish'. 'Dangerous Art' is the high-suspense sequel.

"I am delighted to be embarking on a series of events to launch 'Dangerous Art' and support National Crime Reading Month," says Terry. "This annual event is held throughout June to promote the world's most popular and best-selling genre.
